PENTATHLON CROSS

Athletes who qualify on the Dutch Open Coubertin Cup 2016 will receive the Pentathlon Cross ('Nationale Vijfkampkruis NOC*NSF'), an official decoration for physical performance recognized by the Government of the Netherlands. The Pentathlon Cross has been earned by athletes in Modern and Military Pentathlon since 1916, when the first Pentathlon was hosted in the Netherlands. The rules for the Pentathlon Cross can be found here (in Dutch). A few rules additional to the UIPM rules apply.

TRANSPORT

Attention: We offer two kinds of transport:

- 1. Transport between the official hotels to the venues (€ 70,00 additional fee per day for transport and lunch)
- 2. Transport from the official airport Schiphol-Amsterdam to the official hotels (additional fee € 100,00 P.P. only from official airport to official hotels)

Airport Schiphol-Amsterdam is located 100km from Arnhem where the venues and hotels are. From the Airport Schiphol-Amsterdam there is an excellent railway connection to Arnhem and when traveling by car, Arnhem and Sports centre Papendal can easily be reached. For teams choosing to fly into alternative airports or choose not to use the additional transport, will be responsible for arranging your own ground transportation accordingly. Car parking for teams can be arranged close proximity to the accommodation if agreed with the LOC in advance.

- Included in the participation fee is the use of a horse. For the extra fees and possibilities see the financial conditions.
- There is no limit to the number of participants per country and no minimum or maximum of participants for the event.
